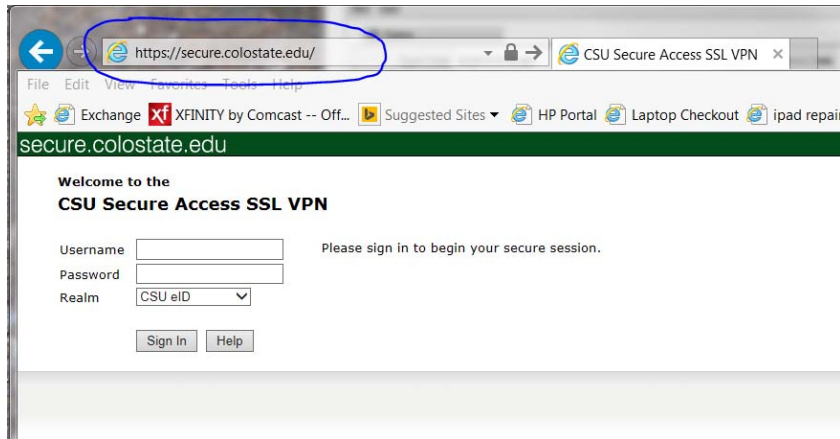
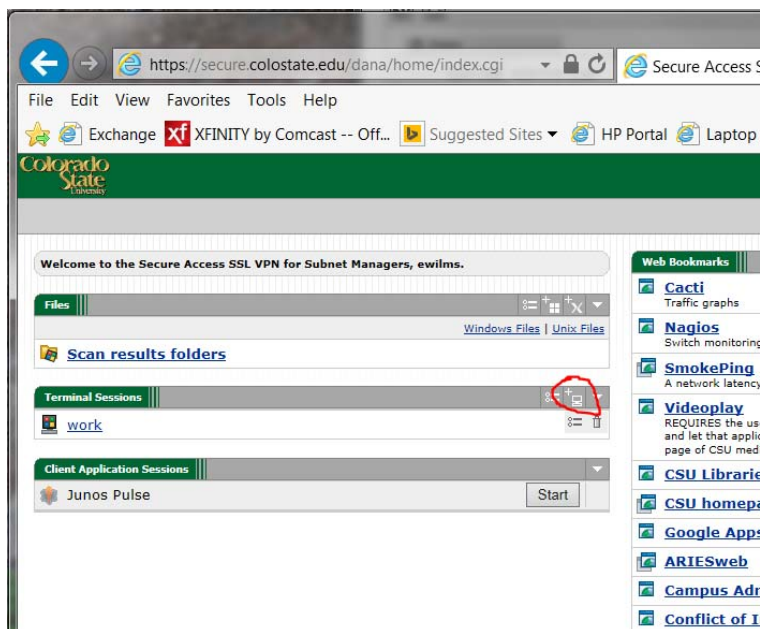


To setup a remote connection to your computer:

1. Open a browser and go to [secure.colostate.edu](https://secure.colostate.edu/).
2. Login using your eid. You will also be required to do Duo authentication



3. Under the "Terminal Sessions" heading, click on the "add a terminal session" icon



4. You will need to enter several bits of information
  - a. Bookmark Name – Just enter something descriptive. Your name or CSU or Work or whatever you want to name it.
  - b. Host – this is your computer name in the form of `computername.acns.colostate.edu` In the example below I've entered Erika's computername. If you don't know your computername, see Looking up Computername.
  - c. Color Depth – Default is 8-bit. I recommend selecting 32-bit from the drop down menu
  - d. Select "Connect local drives"
  - e. Select "Allow clipboard sharing"
  - f. Click on "Add"
